These expectations are outlined in order to ensure that the Ocean Shores Wearable Art show runs as safely and smoothly as possible – and so you can perform your best! We all have to work together to make the show possible! ☐ I will dress in my Wearable piece for dress rehearsal on Friday, or be prepared to show the completed piece I am wearing for the performance. ☐ I will arrive by 5:30pm for the show on Saturday. ☐ I will check in with the Stage Manager as I arrive for performances and will provide the name of the Artist to the Stage Manager. ☐ I will not go beyond the dressing room/ bathroom area in costume. It is unprofessional and detracts from the actual performance. ☐ I will keep curtains to the performance area closed at all times during the show. (In other words, don't hold the curtains open to watch performances, and limit coming in and out- it is incredibly distracting to both the audience and models.) ☐ I will use my indoor voice backstage. Yes, you've heard this many times before in Kindergarten, but... it must be said. Backstage noise can be heard by the audience, and hinders backstage communication. Shhhhhhhhl! ☐ I will not touch or move the costumes of other artists/models. Because many of the pieces are delicate, please don't touch or move a costume unless it belongs to you or you have permission from the artist or model. ☐ I will not use my glue gun backstage. Not only do you risk making a mess, you are putting everyone's safety at risk. It can also cause a breaker to go... shutting off music, mics, lights... yikes! ☐ I will clean up after myself. Don't make a mess in the backstage area, including thrown glitter or spilled liquidscostumes may be ruined, and we are all responsible for cleaning the shared space.

Each artist can submit up to two entries. Entries can contain multiple models.

- Entry fee is \$20 per entry. Checks made out to: Stage West Community Theatre
- Performance may not exceed 2:45 minutes in length. Your music will be faded out after that time.
- Artists must provide a model for the show. (Outof-town artists in need of a model can contact OSWA for help in arranging a model.)
- Models cannot appear in more than two pieces.
- A photographer will document the event for OSWA. It is the responsibility of the artist to inform models that photos may be used in publicizing the Ocean Shores Wearable Art Show. Models will be required to sign a release form.
- Wearable art must be handcrafted. No readymade costumes.
- While OSWA reserves the right to exclude work that is incomplete or inappropriate for the show, we in no way wish to discourage provocative, challenging and mature art.
- Please provide a Sketch or Photo of your piece (completed or not) by April 30.
- Some assistance will be provide for dressing. Only Artist and Model may be allowed backstage unless arrangements are made. Dressing areas for men and women will be provided.
- DRESS REHEARSAL: OS Convention Center

Attendance is mandatory for both artist & model. Model must be dressed in the piece or have it to show the producers at the Friday 5:30pm Q&A meeting followed by runway rehearsal.
